

# Documents Required

# JUST MARRIED WEDDINGS

## For each Bride / Groom / Partner

Please upload these documents to your dashboard or send a photo of them to your celebrant at least 2 business days before your ceremony

### 1) Passport

- can be from any country
- can be out of date as long as the photo still looks like you
- send a photo or colour scan of the original
- If you don't have a passport you can use a current driver licence and birth certificate (must be a photo or colour scan of the original)\*

### 2) If you have been married before

- your divorce certificate, demonstrating that your divorce is final (if you are divorced)\* or
- death certificate for your former spouse (if you are a widow/er)\*

\* If any document is not in English an official translation by an accredited translator must be provided as well as the original.

## For each couple

Please bring these things on the day of your ceremony

### 3) Two witnesses

- note that at most locations except the Brisbane Office we can find passers-by to be your witnesses. Please text your celebrant to let them know if this is your plan.
- at the Brisbane Office you can hire witnesses if you need, this must be booked in advance.

### 4) Authorised Translator

- if either of you don't speak, read and understand English.
- please let us know ASAP if this is the case.
